

Leader: How does holy baptism remind and assure you that Christ's one sacrifice on the cross benefits you personally? All: In this way: Christ instituted this outward washing and with it promised that, as surely as water washes away

the dirt from the body, so certainly his blood and his Spirit wash away my soul's impurity, that is, all my sins.

Leader: What does it mean to be washed with Christ's blood? All: To be washed with Christ's blood means that God, by grace, has forgiven our sins because of Christ's blood
